LIFEgroups are the small family units within the larger Glendale Church family. Led by commissioned Lay Pastors (see note at end of this article), these home groups provide a healthy,

caring, spiritual atmosphere where you can belong, believe, and become the person God created you to be.

Some groups include families with children; some are "adults only." Some groups begin with a meal; others provide refreshments before or after the Bible study.
