



VI. Israel comes full circle

- God brought Israel out of Babylon, in their ancestor Abraham, not to establish a special blood line, but to A. establish a sacred line of faith which was to serve as a beacon of light and truth, a missionary nation, revealing the way of salvation to a dark world.
- God sent Israel BACK TO <u>BABYLON</u> because they failed to fulfill the purpose for which they were B. established, choosing rather to be like the Babylonians. In their hearts they were Babylonians, so God sent them back to live in Babylon.
