14. How did Sunday keeping come into the Church?

Main Factors in the Rise of Sunday Observance among Early Christians

- a. Push of Anti-semitism
- b. Pull of Pagan culture
- c. Celebration of the Resurrection - Yearly "Easter" celebrations
Earliest clear "weekly" Sunday references date after 200 AD
 - 1) Sabbath Fast - Sunday Feast
 - 2) Lord's Day - Revelation 1:10 (1174)
325 AD - Sylvester, bishop of Rome (314 to 347) - Officially changed title of first day to Lord's Day

d. Coercion of Legislation

- 1) 303-313 - Dioclecian persecution
- 2) 313 - Constantine - Edict of Milan - Christianity legalized
- 3) 321 AD - Constantine - Pro-Sunday legislation
Legislated the “*venerable Day of the Sun*” as the day of rest in the Roman Empire
- 4) 364 AD - Council of Laodicea - Anti-Sabbath legislation
“*Christians shall not Judaize and be idle on Saturday but shall work on that day but the Lord's day they shall especially honor, and, as being Christians, shall, if possible, do no work on that day. If, however, they are found Judaizing, they shall be shut out from Christ.*”
