 - a. Matthew 13:34 (984) Taught in parables
 - b. John 11:45-53 (1039) Kill Jesus
 - c. John 12:10-11 (1040) Kill Lazarus
- 5. Parable of Wheat and Tares Matthew 13:24-30, 36-43 (948)
- 6. Forever
 - a. Galatians 1:3-4 (1120) Present evil forever
 - b. Romans 12:2 (1095) Conformed to this forever
 - c. Ephesians 2:1-2 (1125) Course of this forever
 - d. 2 Corinthians 4:3-4 (1101) God of this forever

- e. Luke 1:70 (991) Since the forever began
- f. 1 Corinthians 2:7-8 (1100) Before the forevers
- g. Matthew 12:32 (946) In this forever or in the forever to come
- h. Hebrews 1:1-2 (1147) He made the forevers
- i. Mark 10:29-30 (980) In the forever to come, forever life
- j. John 11:26 (1039) Will not die unto the forever

7. Forever fire and punishment

- a. Matthew 18:8 (953) Forever fire
- b. Matthew 25:41, 46 (962) Forever punishment forever life
- c. Jude 1:7 (1173) Forever fire
- d. 2 Peter 2:6 (1166) Into ashes

8. Destruction

- a. Nahum 1:9-10 (906) Devoured like stubble
- b. Psalm 37:20 (534) Perish vanish into smoke
- c. Malachi 4:1-3 (931) Burn them up leave neither root nor branch
- d. Isaiah 47:14 (704) Burned like stubble no fire or coal remains
- e. 2 Peter 3:1-13 (1167) Burned up dissolved elements melt

9. Restoration

- a. Acts 3:19-21 (1054) Restoration of all things
- b. Genesis 3:15 (3) Promised in the beginning
- c. Revelation 21:4-5 (1189) Accomplished in the end All things new

10. Two Sides of God's Glory

- a. 2 Thessalonians 1:6-10 (1138) Glorification or "forever" destruction
- b. Hebrews 12:29 (1157) Flaming fire

11. God's attitude toward the lost

- a. Ezekiel 33:11 (837) No pleasure in death of wicked
- b. John 3:16-17 (1027) Not to condemn, but to save
- c. 2 Corinthians 5:18-19 (1114) Reconciling the world
- d. 2 Peter 3:9 (1167) Not willing that any perish
- e. 1 Timothy 2:3-4 (1140) Desires all to be saved
- f. Isaiah 28:21 (681) God's unusual act

12. Living in Eternal Fire - Isaiah 33:14-16 (687) - Who will dwell in eternal fire?

13. Forever smoke and torment

- a. Revelation 19:1-3 (1187) Smoke rises up forever and ever
- b. Revelation 14:9-11 (1184) Smoke of their torment ascends forever and ever
- c. Revelation 20:10 (1188) Tormented day and night forever and ever
